

Submitting a survey on the FrogWatch SA website

It's easy to submit a survey using the website.

You will need to have made an audio recording in another app or other device and transferred it, along with any photos, to the computer, tablet or phone you're going to submit the survey from. You'll also need to have made notes about the weather, the GPS location and other details about the site you surveyed.





Once you're ready to submit your survey, simply click on **Submit a survey**, which can be found under **MANAGE SURVEYS** from the menu




You will need to be registered and logged in. If you aren't, you'll see a message like this:



Just enter your email address and password, then click **Login**. If you aren't currently registered, click on **Register** to create an account. You'll be prompted to choose a username and password and an email will be sent to your specified email address to verify your details.

When you're logged in, you'll be able enter the date of your survey using the interactive calendar.



Then, using the dropdown box, enter the time you undertook the survey.

Note: You can only enter the time in 30 min blocks, so choose the time closest to the actual time you surveyed.

*Note: If you click on **Save** at this point, you'll probably get an error telling you that some of the survey details are incomplete. It is best to use the tabs to enter all of the survey information before selecting **Save**.*

From the **Files** tab, you can upload the audio recording and any photos. Simply click on **Browse** then use the dialog box to find the files on your computer or phone and upload them to the survey.

Note: photos must be in JPG format but a range of common audio file types are accepted.



Then click on the **Species** tab to move onto the section where you'll enter information about the frogs you can hear calling.



*Note: **Discrete non-overlapping calls** means that some frogs were calling but the individuals didn't call over the top of each other. **Discrete overlapping calls** means that some frogs called at the same time as each other, but you could pick out individuals. **Full chorus** means that multiple frogs were calling and the same time and it was tricky or impossible to discern one individual from another.*

If you are confident at frog identification (or want to test your skills) you can use the Species heard section to enter the details of any or all species that you hear. If you do not know the identification of the frogs you have recorded, you do not need to enter the **Species heard** section, but you will still need to select the **Call type** and **Are frogs calling** information.

Use the **Select a species** dropdown to choose from the list of frog species

Assuming you haven't forgotten anything, you'll get the message stating that your survey has been saved.

If you're happy with everything, click on the **Publish now** button to make the survey live on our website.


